SEPLINE aims to promote knowledge sharing, enhance comparability of research results, and facilitate research on socioeconomic differences in cancer outcomes

The widely observed socioeconomic differences in cancer outcomes in Denmark are a highly prioritized health political and clinical focus area. Current knowledge of inequality across cancers and over time is, however, challenged by large national differences in how socioeconomic differences are measured and analyzed.

Over two workshops, participants will share knowledge and experiences, and prepare specific recommendations for measures of socioeconomic position and methods for analyses, which will be pilot-tested in data and summarized in a national guideline.
