

Call for abstracts

Background

Danish Cancer Research Days is the largest Danish cancer conference, bringing together researchers, clinicians, patients and policy makers. We will again this year invite selected submitters to present their research on stage. Danish Comprehensive Cancer Center (DCCC) and the Danish Multidisciplinary Cancer Groups (DMCG.dk) hope to see you at the Danish Cancer Research Days.

Invitation to present research findings

During the conference, we would like to cover current research ranging from across the entire Danish cancer research field. We invite all those interested to submit abstracts on research projects, clinical trials or other research activities related to cancer. Abstracts will be evaluated on the basis of cancer relevance as well as on the outcomes, quality, and generalisability of the research. In addition, the perspectives of the project; how newsworthy the study is and the extent of the national embedding will be taken into consideration. Abstracts on ongoing projects and clinical protocols are also welcome.

If your submitted abstract is accepted for this conference, you will receive further practical information. Please note that the poster must be publishable at the time of the conference. We expect all posters to be available on both conference days of August 31st and 1st of September 2023. We also ask you to be aware that getting your abstract accepted does not automatically register you for the conference.

Two types of presentation on stage

Head stage session: Seven young scientist abstract submitters will be given the opportunity to present their research on stage in the session '*Aktuel dansk kræftforskning i rampelyset*' / '*Current Danish cancer research in the spotlight*'. After submission deadline, seven presenters will be selected; information about this process will be sent directly to the selected presenters. The criteria for selection are originality, scientific quality, and cancer relevance.

Small stage flash talks: Furthermore, there will be a flash talk stage near the poster sessions. A selected number of participants will be invited to present their work using a maximum of 3 slides. Information about this process will be sent directly to the selected presenters.

Formal requirements

We call for abstracts within **the entire cancer field**. The categories in the submission form are as follows; please choose the most fitting category.

- Screening & early diagnosis
- Personalised medicine, biomarkers & diagnostics
- Clinical trials
- Emerging treatments
- Morbidity, late effects & rehabilitation
- Patient involvement
- Palliation and psychosocial support
- Clinical epidemiology and database research

Please be careful that all information, titles, grammar etc. is correct, as the text will be used to generate an electronic abstract book for all participants at Danish Cancer Research Days which will be accessible online as previous years.

The form is structured as shown below

Abstract title: Max 250 characters including spaces.

Category: Choose the most fitting of the given categories.

Presenting author: Please enter your full name as follows: e.g. Peter Sindbjerg Petersen.

Presenting author's email: Only one abstract is allowed per presenting author.

Please enter the email address, where we can best reach you.

Presenting author's title: e.g. PhD student, professor.

Presenting author's affiliation: Department, Institution.

Authors and affiliation: Please list all authors (please include presenting author again) with last name followed by initials, followed by department and institution (e.g. Pedersen, P.S., Department of Nuclear Medicine, Aarhus University Hospital). If two or more authors share the same affiliation, please use numbering.

Abstract text: Please structure as follows and please include these headlines in the text:

Introduction | Materials and Methods | Results | Conclusions.

Max. 2000 characters including spaces. It is NOT possible to upload tables and figures.

The presenting author is responsible for presenting the poster. Only one abstract per presenting author is allowed. Abstracts and posters can be made and presented in either Danish or English according to your preference.

Submission deadline

We request that you submit your abstract through the link above no later than April 19., 2023.

Information regarding acceptance will be sent to the listed e-mail address by June 2, 2023.

Separate information will be sent to those who are selected to present on the stages.

Registration for the conference

Registration for the conference opens early May on www.dccc.dk and www.dmcg.dk and ends early July.

Please note: submitting an abstract is **not** a registration for the conference.
