DOC – the DCCC Onco-Cardiology Group – hereby invites to the third meeting on onco-cardiologic research projects in Denmark.

Since last meeting

The first national meeting in DOC was held on June 18th-20th, 2018. Forty-one doctors, specialized in oncology, cardiology, epidemiology, pediatrics or nuclear medicine, and medical physicists participated. The aim of the meeting was to write research protocols regarding heart disease after oncological treatment. National participation in the studies and collaboration across the different specialties were of high priority. During the meeting, many ideas and proposals for studies were presented, which resulted in six working groups with different focus areas. Nine protocols were proposed and at least two led to PhD projects currently under development.

During the meeting, the network, both professionally and socially, was strengthened across the different specialties creating a solid foundation for future collaboration.

On January 17th, 2019, a second meeting was held in Odense. At that meeting, the projects established during the first meeting were discussed and improved.

Aim

We now invite to the third meeting at Sandbjerg Gods, near Sønderborg, Denmark. The meeting is planned on May 26th-27th, 2021.

The aim of the meeting is to provide an update on current onco-cardiologic projects and develop new projects to gain more knowledge on heart disease after oncological treatment and improve treatment of cancer patients with heart disease.

During the meeting there will be time to develop and optimize new project ideas. The focus is on national and interdisciplinary projects with participation from oncologists, cardiologists, medical physicists, and other relevant specialties.

Participation in the meeting is achieved by submitting a few lines motivated short application, preferably consisting of ideas for future projects. The meeting is aimed at researchers in the various disciplines of onco-cardiological research. There are finances for the participation of approx. 40 people. DOC covers the meeting costs (including board and lodging, but not transportation).

The meeting might be cancelled if corona virus and applicable guidelines do not allow physical participation. If the meeting is cancelled, we will postpone the meeting instead of planning virtual participation, as one of the main objectives is networking.
